

NACSW/K9 Nose Work® Instructor Program CNWI™ Continuing Education Units Worksheet

Certified Nose Work Instructors (CNWI) are required to continue educational training to maintain their certification status as ‘current’ in the instructor directory on the K9NW website. Each instructor is required to obtain 24 continuing education units per two-year cycle with the first due two years from their initial certification date and every two thereafter.

Beginning April 1, 2017 all CNWI’s will complete the recertification process through <http://k9nosework.com/ceu>. There is a \$75.00 recertification fee due at the time of renewal.
